ONE-DAY SUSTAINABILITY QUEST!

Students work in teams to learn about water use and water quality, waste recycling, composting, the weather, energy efficiency and building design. The experience will help students develop and implement their own sustainable living practices at school and at home.

After lunch, they explore the hidden world of Narmbool's terrestrial and aquatic insects, and 'create a critter' that could survive at Narmbool.
